#### TEACHERS AND THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES

#### **TEACHER**

A person who adopts teaching as a profession is obliged to conduct him/her in accordance with the ideal of the profession. Teacher should make sure that there is no incompatibility between his precepts and practice. Any person who holds the position of teaching as profession should be calm, patient and communicative by temperament and amiable in disposition.

#### TEACHERS AND THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES:

#### Teachers should:

co-curricular and extra-curricular activities including Community service. Teachers should try to be members in professional organizations and strive to improve education and profession through them. Teachers should try to grow through continuous study and research.

# **Teachers Responsibilities towards students**

Teachers should encourage students to improve their attainments, develop their personalities and at the same time contribute to community welfare. Students should be dealt with justly and impartially regardless of their religion, caste, political, economic, social and physical characteristics. Students should be encouraged to express his/her opinion with dignity. Teachers should be affectionate to students and should not behave in a vindictive manner towards any of them under any circumstances. Teachers should be available to the students even beyond the class hours and should help and help them without any remuneration or reward.

### Teacher's responsibilities towards colleagues

Teachers should treat other colleagues in the same manner as they themselves wish to be treated. Teachers should speak respectfully with other teachers and render assistance for professional betterment. They should keep away from lodging unsubstantiated allegations against colleagues to higher authorities and teachers should not discriminate colleagues on caste, creed, religion, race or sex in their profession.

### Teacher's responsibilities towards authorities

Teachers should keep away from undertaking any other employment which is likely to interfere with their professional responsibilities. Teachers should discharge their professional responsibilities according to the existing rules and adhere to procedures and methods consistent with their profession. Teachers should respect the conditions of contract. Teachers co-operate in the formulation of policies of the institution by accepting various offices and discharge responsibilities as per the demand. Teachers should co operate with the authorities for the betterment of the institutions keeping in view the interest and in conformity with dignity of the profession.

# Teacher's responsibilities towards Non teaching staffs

Teachers should treat the non-teaching staff as colleagues and equal partners and should help them in their function which requires teachers support.

# Teacher's responsibilities towards Guardians

Teachers should maintain contact with the guardians, and send reports of their performance to them whenever necessary and meet the guardians in meetings convened for the purpose for mutual exchange of ideas..

### Teacher's responsibilities towards society

Teachers should keep away from activities, which tend to promote feeling of hatred or enmity among different communities, religions of linguistic groups but at the same time teachers has to work for National Integration. Teachers have to perform the duties of citizenship and have to participate in community activities. Teachers by keeping in mind that education is a public service has the responsibility to inform public about the educational programmes which are being offered. Teachers have to work to improve education in the community and strengthen the community's moral and intellectual life. Teachers should be aware of social problems and should initiate activities which will help the society to overcome such problems.
